The Master of Science in Education (M.S.Ed.) in Exceptional Student Education/Pre-kindergarten Disabilities/ESOL program focuses on issues and best practices in early childhood special education. The program prepares individuals to work with young children with disabilities and their families in inclusive, collaborative, and natural environments & **meets the requirements for eligibility for endorsements in Pre-kindergarten Disabilities and English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL)**. Depending on a student's background, the program ranges from 33 to 39 credits.

ONLY applicants with Exceptional Student Education (ESE, MR, LD, EH) certification will be considered for admission in May 2008.

Students who begin the program in May 2008 must commit to taking 2-3 courses for 6 consecutive semesters in order to complete their program in August 2009. Classes meet from 5 to 7:40 PM during the Fall and Spring terms and from 4:40 to 8:20 PM during the Summer terms. The program accommodates working teachers by scheduling the two 30-day practicum experiences in the summers. Some workshops and meetings, but no regularly scheduled class sessions, are held on Fridays.

Up to ninety percent (90%) tuition support is available for individuals who qualify for admission.
